- * **originally** [əˈrɪdʒənli] *adv.* 原先、起初、原本
I am originally from New York City, but I have lived in Taichung for five years now.
- * **wealthy** [ˈwelθi] *adj.* 富有的、有錢的
Japan is a very wealthy country with a good standard of living.
- * **system** [ˈsɪstəm] *n.* 系統；體制
Nobody told Lizzy about the new payment system.
- * **remaining** [rɪˈmenɪŋ] *adj.* 剩餘的；其餘的
The remaining people on the beach played in the sea.

- * **similarity** [ˌsɪməˈlɪərəti] *n.* 相似處（可數）
There are some similarities between American football and soccer.
- * **brunch** [brʌntʃ] *n.* 早午餐（是由 breakfast「早餐」和 lunch「午餐」合成的字）
An egg sandwich makes the perfect brunch as it fills you up for the rest of the day.
- * **confirm** [kənˈfɜːm] *v.* 確認、確定；證實
I need to confirm with my dad that we are going camping this weekend.
- * **tasty** [ˈtesti] *adj.* 美味可口的、好吃的
Adding tomato to your burger will make it extra tasty.

- * **adventure** [ədˈvɛntʃə] *n.* 冒險的經歷或活動
The moment Kelly got on the plane, she knew this was going to be an exciting adventure.
- * **fancy** [ˈfænsi] *v.* 想要、想做（後接 N./V-ing）
I think I fancy a burger for lunch, but pizza would be nice too.
- * **tourist** [ˈtʊrɪst] *n.* 旅客、觀光客
Over 16 million tourists visited London in 2022.
- * **indoor** [ɪnˈdɔːr] *adj.* 室內的
I like playing indoor sports the most.

- * **talent** [ˈtælənt] *n.* 天分、天賦；有天分的人
David's parents knew he had a talent for baseball from the first time he played.
- * **shyness** [ˈʃaɪnəs] *n.* 害羞、羞澀
Sadly, shyness can prevent people from making new friends.
- * **attention** [əˈtɛnʃən] *n.* 關注、注意；關心
Timmy always made noise in the classroom as he loved being the center of attention.
- * **international** [ˌɪntəˈnæʃnəl] *adj.* 國際的
Clarissa traveled to a big international festival with her friends last summer.

- * **greenhouse** [ˈɡriːnˌhaʊs] *n.* 溫室
My mom has a greenhouse in her garden.
- * **tiny** [ˈtaɪni] *adj.* 很小的、微小的
Matilda's brother is much taller than her, so she looks tiny when she stands next to him.
- * **reaction** [rɪˈækʃən] *n.* （化學）反應；回應
Bread and cheese are both made by chemical reactions.
- * **powder** [ˈpaʊdə] *n.* 粉、粉末
I think I put too much garlic powder in this soup.

- * **mess** [mes] *n.* （動物的）糞便（可為可數或不可數）；髒亂；混亂
The children left a mess in the living room.
- * **database** [ˈdɛtəˌbeɪs] *n.* 資料庫（可數名詞）
Many schools maintain databases with parents' contact details.
- * **afterward** [ˈæftəwəd] *adv.* 之後、後來（亦可拼作 afterwards）
We went for a long walk, and afterward, we had our lunch by the lake.
- * **bamboo** [bæmˈbuː] *n.* 竹子、竹竿
The bamboo chair was beautifully made and very comfortable to sit on.

- * **scary** [ˈskɛəri] *adj.* 可怕的；恐怖的
I never want to watch that movie again; it was far too scary.
- * **frightening** [ˈfraɪtɪŋɪŋ] *adj.* 令人驚恐的；駭人的
Philippa found the dark frightening and always had to sleep with the lights on.
- * **feather** [ˈfɛðə] *n.* 羽毛
The bird's feathers were the most beautiful the man had ever seen.
- * **mighty** [ˈmaɪti] *adj.* 強有力的；巨大的、強大的
He was considered a mighty king.

- * **flavor** [ˈflevə] *n.* 口味；味道
If you don't use garlic, your food will lack flavor.
- * **invent** [ɪnˈvɛnt] *v.* 發明；創造
Before the telephone was invented, people sent letters to their friends.
- * **fold** [fold] *v.* （將調味料）拌入、加入（用法為 fold sth in 或是 fold sth into N.）；折疊
Tina carefully folded the eggs into the cake mix.
- * **temporarily** [ˌtɛmpəˈrɛrəli] *adv.* 暫時地、臨時地
The sign said that the computer was temporarily out of use.

- * **hometown** [ˈhɒmˈtaʊn] *n.* 家鄉、故鄉
It had been a long time since Alex had returned to her hometown.
- * **skilled** [skɪld] *adj.* 需要專門技能的；熟練的
Tamara is very skilled at the violin.
- * **independent** [ˌɪndəˈpɛndənt] *adj.* 獨立的；自立的
Sid prefers independent coffee shops to the big chains.
- * **manage** [ˈmænɪdʒ] *v.* 設法、順利完成（尤指困難之事，之後接 to V.）
I haven't managed to do my homework yet, but I will finish it by the end of the day.

- * **performance** [pəˈfɔːməns] *n.* 表演、演出；表現
Margot Robbie has earned lots of praise for her performance in *Barbie*.
- * **audience** [ˈɔːdiəns] *n.* （一群）觀眾、聽眾
The audience was excited to find out which song the band would play next.
- * **debt** [det] *n.* 債務；人情債；借款
I owe a debt to my friend after he helped pay for my textbooks during college.
- * **pretend** [prɪˈtend] *v.* 假裝、偽裝
When Joanna was a little girl, she loved to pretend that she was a princess.

- * **career** [kəˈrɪr] *n.* 職業生涯、事業
When you're choosing a career, you should think about what you enjoy doing.
- * **prove** [pruːv] *v.* 證明、證實（之後可接 (that) S. + V.）
He wanted to prove to his boss that he was able to do the task.
- * **challenging** [ˈtʃæləndʒɪŋ] *adj.* 有難度的、具有挑戰性的
I was told that this is the most challenging hiking path on the entire mountain.
- * **passport** [ˈpæs.pɔːrt] *n.* 通行證、護照
You will need a passport if you want to visit other countries.

- * **various** [ˈveəriəs] *adj.* 各種不同的；各式各樣的
There are various ways to get to Keelung from Taipei, but going by car is the fastest.
- * **bay** [beɪ] *n.* 灣、海灣
They walked along the bay and enjoyed the smell of the ocean.
- * **structure** [ˈstrʌktʃə] *n.* 建築物；結構（體）
Taipei 101 is a huge structure that can be seen from across the city.
- * **tower** [ˈtaʊə] *n.* 塔、塔樓
Lisa walked up the stairs to the top of the tower.

- * **amazing** [əˈmeɪzɪŋ] *adj.* 令人稱奇的、驚人的；非常好的
I had an amazing time visiting my family in Tainan.
- * **information** [ˌɪnfəˈmeɪʃən] *n.* 資訊、消息（不可數）
Pay attention when you are reading the book so that you don't miss any key information.
- * **vehicle** [ˈviːkəl] *n.* 車輛；交通工具
Scooters are a very popular vehicle in Taiwan, as everyone seems to have one.
- * **exhibition** [ˌeksəˈbɪʃən] *n.* 展覽會；展示
Tim went to a really good exhibition about baseball at his local museum.

- * **release** [rɪˈliːs] *v.* 排放；釋放；發行、公布
Cars release gasses into the air that are bad for the planet.
- * **plastic** [ˈplæstɪk] *adj.* 塑膠（製）的
I like to make things out of old plastic bottles.
- * **prevent** [prɪˈvent] *v.* 預防、阻止（prevent sth/sb from V-ing 表示「防止某事物……；使某人無法……」）
Chloe was prevented from sleeping by the loud music playing next door.
- * **dinosaur** [ˈdaɪnə.sɔːr] *n.* 恐龍
Dinosaurs lived on our planet many millions of years ago.

- * **replace** [rɪˈpleɪs] *v.* 更換、代替
She bought some new curtains to replace the old ones.
- * **meanwhile** [ˈmiːnwaɪl] *adv.* 同時；在此期間
She started cooking dinner; meanwhile, her brother set the table.
- * **prefer** [prɪˈfɜː] *v.* 比較喜歡、偏好（prefer A to B 指「喜歡 A 勝過 B」）
I prefer the taste of chicken to pork.
- * **available** [əˈveɪləbəl] *adj.* 可買到的；可得到的；可用的
There were only five seats available for the 9:30 a.m. train.

- * **kilometer** [kəˈlɒmətə] *n.* 公里（也可唸成 [ˈkɪlə.mɪtə]，字首 kilo- 表示「千」的意思）
I work over three kilometers away from where I live.
- * **roughly** [ˈrʌfli] *adv.* 大致上、大概；粗略地
She knew that Tim was roughly 30 years old, but she didn't know exactly when he was born.
- * **roar** [rɔːr] *v., n.* 咆哮、吼叫
Lions roar to show how strong they are.
- * **designer** [dɪˈzaɪnə] *n.* 設計師；設計者
The car's designer came onto the stage to tell us about all the cool new things it can do.

- * **satisfy** [ˈsætəsˌfaɪ] *v.* 使滿足、使滿意
The director knew that the movie's ending wouldn't satisfy everyone.
- * **throughout** [θruːˈaʊt] *prep.* 從頭到尾、自始至終
Jenny annoyed her friend by singing throughout the day.
- * **technique** [tekˈnik] *n.* 技法、技能；技巧
Ms. White has a special technique to help her students read difficult words.
- * **backward** [ˈbækwəd] *adv.* 反向地；向後地
The car started to roll backward down the hill.

- * **scientist** [ˈsaɪəntɪst] *n.* 科學家
Sir Isaac Newton is one of the most famous scientists in history.
- * **ideal** [aɪˈdiəl] *adj.* 非常合適的、理想的
Tomorrow's weather will be ideal for the beach.
- timber** [ˈtɪmbə] *n.* 木材、原木
He built his own house using only timber.
- * **painful** [ˈpeɪnfəl] *adj.* 疼痛的；痛苦的、難受的
Breaking my arm was the most painful experience of my life.

- * **fur** [fɜː] *n.* (動物的) 毛、毛皮
Be sure to cut your dog's fur in the summer so it doesn't get too hot.
- * **chest** [tʃɛst] *n.* 胸膛、胸部；胸腔

- * **vision** [ˈvɪʒən] *n.* 視力；遠見
My vision is very poor when I don't wear my glasses.
- * **crawl** [krɔːl] *v.* 爬行；匍匐前進；緩慢移動
The baby started to crawl across the living room floor.

- combine A and/with B** A 和 B 兩者兼具
Her food combines Eastern and Western cooking to create something new.
- come alive** (地方) 變得熱鬧、活躍起來
The city really comes alive at night.
- on the other hand** 另一方面
Betty loves living in the city; on the other hand, it can be too noisy at times.

- * **thankfully** [ˈθæŋkflɪ] *adv.* 幸虧、幸好；感謝地
I forgot to bring my homework to school today, but thankfully Mr. Daniels wasn't too angry.
- pancake** [ˈpænˌkek] *n.* 煎餅
Pancakes are not very healthy, so I don't eat them every day.
- * **victory** [ˈvɪktri] *n.* 勝利、獲勝
Sammy's victory in the race was celebrated by her friends and family.
- * **captain** [ˈkæptən] *n.* (競賽或運動) 隊長；船長
He has been the team's captain for three months.

I could feel the car heat up after the engine was switched on.
- make out** 塑造成、力圖描述成(某種錯誤的形象)
The newspapers made Chloe out to be a hero.
- it is possible that S. + V.** ……是可能的
It is possible that Jake ate all of the cookies.
- be meant to V.** 用意是……；目的是……
A helmet is meant to protect your head during accidents.

- * **marvelous** [ˈmɑːvləs] *adj.* 好極的；不可思議的
Ms. Sanderson thought Joey was a marvelous little boy with lots of good ideas.
- * **alphabet** [ˈælfəˌbet] *n.* (一種語言的) 全部字母
By the time she was three years old, Penny already knew the whole alphabet.
- * **style** [staɪl] *n.* 樣式、風格
The author's unique style of writing made him very popular.
- * **employ** [ɪmˈplɔɪ] *v.* 使用、採用；利用
Ms. Connors employed every effort to make the class as fun as possible.

Chris was so tired that he went to bed as soon as he got home.
- be made out of N.** 由……製作、改造而成
The children's toys were made out of wood.
- find + oneself + O.C.** 發現自己(不知不覺)在做某事、身處……之中
After the news report, Victor found himself the center of attention everywhere he went.
- credit sb/sth as N./V-ing** 認為……是……
She credits her parents as her biggest influence.

- * **effective** [ɪˈfektɪv] *adj.* 有效的；產生預期效果的
Walking to work instead of taking the MRT is an effective way to save money.
- * **perform** [pəˈfɔrm] *v.* 執行、進行；表演、演出
I hope Taylor Swift sings "Shake It Off" when I see her perform next month.
- * **wage** [wedʒ] *n.* 工資、工錢；薪水
If you want to keep me at the company, then you need to pay me a higher wage.
- * **forever** [fəˈrevə] *adv.* 永遠；總是；長久地
The husband told his wife that he would love her forever.

- * **goal** [gɒl] *n.* 目標、目的

- * **constantly** [ˈkɒnstəntli] *adv.* 持續不斷地；時常地；始終
Angela is constantly checking her phone for new messages.
- * **stressed** [streɪst] *adj.* 緊張的、焦慮不安的
Brian was feeling stressed before his driving test.
- * **weigh** [weɪ] *v.* 重量有……、重達……
The box weighs one kilogram.

- come into contact with + N.** 接觸到……
Many people come into contact with illnesses when using public transport.

- * **regularly** [ˈregjələli] *adv.* 經常；有規律地
Flora regularly reads stories to her baby sister.
- * **extreme** [ɪkˈstri:m] *adj.* 極端的；激烈的
I have never experienced extreme heat like this before.
- * **frequent** [ˈfrikwənt] *adj.* 經常發生的；頻繁的
Frequent exercise will make you feel happier and healthier.
- * **destroy** [dɪˈstrɔɪ] *v.* 摧毀、破壞
The old building was destroyed by the strong winds.

She applied for a manager's position at the newly opened store.
