- * **fortunately** [ˈfɔ:tʃənətli] *adv.* 幸好; 幸運的是
Fortunately, we arrived at the station just in time to catch the last train home.

You should adapt your cooking style to the ingredients you have at home.

- * **rage** [redʒ] *v.* (爭論、戰鬥等) 激烈進行

- * **competitor** [kəmˈpetətə] *n.* 競爭對手; 參賽者

- * **creation** [kriˈeɪʃən] *n.* 創造物; 藝術作品 (可數); 創造、創立 (不可數)
She showed me her latest creation, a beautiful drawing of our house.
- * **crispy** [ˈkrɪspi] *adj.* 脆的、酥脆的; 鮮脆的
The fried chicken had perfectly crispy skin.

- * **imagination** [ɪ.mædʒəˈneɪʃən] *n.* 想像 (力)
With her imagination, she turned her garden into a magical land where she was the queen.
- * **adventure** [ədˈvɛntʃə] *n.* 冒險; 冒險經歷
We packed our bags and set off on an adventure.
